## Fencing Specifications & Submission Guidelines

Updated May 2026

Fencing is allowed on YOUR property only with prior approval from the Board of Directors. Below are the guidelines for submitting your fence request. Please be sure to include all items to help expedite the process, thus saving you time and money. Email your submission to: [magdalena@mwcpaa.com](mailto:magdalena@mwcpaa.com) and [trmdoperations@gmail.com](mailto:trmdoperations@gmail.com)

**Remember, any unauthorized fences may result in a fine and be removed at your expense.**

### Submissions Check List

- DRB Form found [HERE](#)
- Hire a surveyor to demarcate both your property line AND the utility easement(s). Although this is an added cost initially, it could save you a lot more than if you need to move your fence. Be sure to include photos taken of the surveyor's flags.
  - Colorado requires that if you're digging deep or even just a few inches, you must contact Colorado 811 to have underground utilities marked. Find more information [HERE](#).
- A scaled map of your property that indicates:
  1. The property line and utility easement(s)
  2. Your proposed fence line
  3. Fencing heights for all sides of the fencing (*see specifications below*)
  4. Gate access
- Photos of the fencing color, material and style you wish to use (*see specifications below*)

### Fencing Specifications\*

Approved fencing colors: White or Natural

Approved fencing materials: Vinyl or Wood

Approved fencing heights: Front yard – 3' 6" max Back yard – 6' max

Approved fence styles: Picket or Dog-Eared



**\*\*All posts must be installed on the *inside* (property side) of the fence\*\***

**\*\*Note: Installing a fence will result in no longer providing service to the front, side, and rear lawns, including mowing and weed treatment per the current [Landscaping Policy](#)\*\***
